PROGRAM: Solo Technical, Solo Free, Duet Technical, Duet Free, Mixed Duet Technical,

Mixed Duet Free, Team Technical, Team Free, Free Combination and

Highlight Routine.

**ENTRIES:** Two Solo Technical, Two Solo Free, Two Duet Technical, Two Duet Free, Two

Mixed Duet Technical, Two Mixed Duet Free, One Team Technical, One Team

Free, One Free Combination and One Highlight Routine.

The maximum number of athletes entered per National Federation shall be twelve (12). If a federation participates in Mixed Duet, the maximum number

of athletes is fourteen (14).

**DRAW:** The draw for all sessions will be done on April 26th at Technical Meeting.

**RULES:** This competition will be held under FINA Rules 2017-2021.

In case more than one entry per nation swim the event, only the best one will

be allowed to the podium.

#### **Rules and Regulations 2019 Update**

• 5.2 Technical Officials: Every participating NF must bring a minimum of one A or G FINA judge and a maximum of two to every meet they enter. An A judge will be given priority over G judges and all FINA judges must have successfully passed the Judges Exam administered at a FINA Artistic Swimming Judges Certification in School in 2018, and the 2018 on line exam and be on the current FINA List. The list of judges for each competition must be sent in advance to the FINA office.

Practice judges are accepted at all events of the Series, maximum one judge per Federation.

- 5.3 Neutral Judges: Neutral Judges are invited to apply to the OC to attend World Series. In the event of low foreign participation in a ASWS Leg FINA may appoint one (1) or two (2) neutral judges to ensure a balance between the judges' nationalities
  - National Federation judges may be used if they have FINA status or have passed the Advanced Exam.

**AWARDS:**  $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$  place of each event shall be awarded respectively.

**DOPING CONTROL:** According to FINA Rules.

**TICKET:** Please contact the OC.

**GALA:** Each federation attending the event should be asked to come prepared with at least one Exhibition Gala Show. A routine with no rules; make up welcome; accessories welcome. These are different routines than the competition routines and it is providing the athlete with a moment to shine and show their personalities.
