Rules: Competition will be held under FINA Rules and Japanese rules.

Officials: Each participating federation may send a 2011 FINA listed judge according to the following financial conditions. A Judge must have passed the FINA Judges Test (Exam) at one of the FINA Judges Schools after November 2009.

Practice Judge: Each federation may send a practice judge at your own expense. Evaluation will be held.

Events and Solo, Duet, Team and Free Combination

Program: Solo, Duet, Team: Technical routine + Free routine

Free Combination: 100%

Entry: Solo / 1, Duet / 1, Team / 1, Free Combination / 1

The number of athletes in Team event may be four to eight (4-8). Changes in the number of athletes between preliminaries and finals, and between the Technical and Free Routines will not be allowed. The maximum number of athletes entered per National Federation shall be twelve (12).

Awards: $1^{\text{st}} - 3^{\text{rd}}$ place of each event (Solo, Team, Duet, and Free Combination) shall be

awarded respectively.

According to the Japanese rules, the reserve swimmers who did not swim any

routines can't get medals.
